- ✓ The Governing Council discussed about the Anna University odd Semester results.
- ✓ The Governing Body approved the Academic Calendar for the even semester and various events planned for this semester.

❖ Admission

- ✓ The Governing Body discussed about any readmission in any departments.

❖ Budget and Proposals

- ✓ The Management has proposed that Heads of the Departments (HODs) should prepare a budget for the academic year 2023 – 2024.
- ✓ The Governing Body has planned to propose secured RFID Library Management system.
- ✓ The Governing Body discussed the financial support for faculty as per the HR Policy.
- ✓ The Governing Body thoroughly discussed and review of the audited financial statements and expressed satisfaction with the transparency exhibited in the audited statement of accounts for the year 2022-2023.

- ✓ The Governing Body discussed about the Naan Mudhalvan initiative for the students as per Tamil Nadu government instruction.
- ✓ The Governing Council discussed that software's for Accounts, Students and Faculty database, Academic, HR, Transport, Examination and Library are in existence. In order to establish centralized system, it has been planned to implement ERP software in the institution.
- ✓ The Governing Body as suggested to verify the progress of green energy QRO certification.
- ✓ The Management discussed about relieving of the faculty members for the academic year.
- ✓ The Management initiated the discussion by highlighting the importance of providing industry training opportunities to faculty members to enhance their professional development and ensure the relevance of academic programs to industry needs.
